A Few Cold Weather Reminders

When winter weather hits, there will be circumstances when transportation will have to be delayed or cancelled for Adult Services, or STAR, Inc. Some who attend programming based at STAR choose to use private transport; the center will be open to serve them, even if the buses are delayed or not running that day.

■ On days when transportation is cancelled Administration, Service & Support Administration (SSA), and STAR will typically remain open, so individuals can provide their own transportation.

■ Bus drivers are supported in using their own discretion when it comes to winter driving. This may include bus drivers making the choice to avoid certain roads that are known to be hazardous during inclement weather.

■ Scioto County Developmental Disabilities offers a taxpayer-funded

service that is a healthy and safe learning environment. It is an option to attend; individuals may choose not to attend, that is their right.

■ Scioto County Developmental Disabilities never requires people to board a bus if they feel conditions are unsafe.

Individuals, family members, and providers are also reminded they can always decide not to send an individual to programming, even if transportation is on regular schedule. Conditions may vary countywide, and circumstances and health considerations may require individuals stay home.
