WHAT IS NCI?

The National Core Indicators (NCI) is a way for state developmental disabilities agencies to track and measure their own performance in the form of an in-person survey or conversation with at least 500 randomly selected individuals.

The core indicators are Community Inclusion, Satisfaction, Choice and Decision-Making, Self-Determination, and Employment.

AS AN INTERVIEWER:

We are looking for individuals with developmental disabilities and their family members to be NCI interviewers. Interviewers will conduct face-to-face or Zoom conversations with Ohioans with disabilities for the NCI Adult In-Person Survey (www.nationalcoreindicators.org).

- Receive \$50 per interview carried out and mileage reimbursement
- 45-60 minutes per interview
- Attend an online paid training offered by OSU Nisonger Center
- Schedule your interviews based on your own availability
- Interviewers must provide or arrange their own transportation



EXAMPLES OF SURVEY QUESTIONS:

- Do you like your home?
- Do you feel safe?
- Do you have a paid job in the community?
