POLICY 5.06 NON-ROUTINE USE OF SCHOOL BUSES

- A. "Non-routine uses of school buses" is defined as transportation of passengers for purposes other than regularly scheduled routes to and from school. School buses may be used for non-routine trips only when such trips will not interfere with routine transportation services. Approved non-routine uses of buses include:
 - 1. Trips that are extensions of the instructional program as determined by program administration.
 - 2. Trips for the transportation of enrolled pupils directly participating in school-sponsored events. A "school-sponsored event" is defined as any activity in which pupils are participating and are under the direct supervision and control of a certified staff member or any advisor as designated by the superintendent.
 - Transporting pupils taking part in summer recreation programs when such programs are sponsored by the Board or an entity with which the Board has an agreement.
 - 4. Trips for transportation of pupils and/or adults, as approved by the Board to and from events within the local community which are program or community sponsored.
 - 5. Emergency evacuation and/or emergency evacuation drills when such emergencies are declared by state or local directors of emergency disaster services.
 - 6. A civil emergency as declared by the governor.
 - 7. Transporting program staff engaged in Board-approved employee improvement programs.
- B. Bus trips are to be made only when there is written authorization signed by the superintendent, or designee.
- C. The authorizing document, or 'trip permit' shall accompany the driver on any non-routine trip. The trip permit shall provide information listed below:
 - 1. Date of the trip
 - 2. Destination
 - 3. Purpose of the trip

- 4. Name of the Board
- 5. Driver's Name
- 6. Bus registration of vehicle license number
- 7. Total Miles of the trip
- 8 Designated stops
- 9. Route map and/or written directions for reaching destination
- 10. Names and signatures of the school bus owner, superintendent or designee;
- D. One or more adult chaperones, as approved by the superintendent or designee, shall accompany each school bus required for non-routine trips involving school age students.
- E. Any out of state trip shall remain within two hundred forty miles round trip distance from point of exit from the state to the point of entry to the state.
