**SUBSTITUTE INTERVENTION SPECIALIST**  
(Substitute Teacher for students with multiple disabilities)

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Must be able to present valid credentials for a Bachelor's degree in Education from an accredited institution of higher learning. Must have a valid Long Term Substitute License or be able to attain an Ohio Department of Education Substitute Teaching License. Knowledge of methods for teaching students who have multiple disabilities and use of educational equipment and aids preferred. Ability to define problems, collect data, establish facts and draw valid conclusions. Ability to maintain good rapport with students, parents, staff and other significant persons. Excellent cooperation and communication skills are essential. Applicant must be able to lift moderately heavy objects and physically assist non-ambulatory students.

**JOB DESCRIPTION GUIDELINES:** Includes, but is not limited to the following duties: Fills in for absent teacher for varying students' developmental levels and gathers evaluative data; may be required to create and implement instructional and behavioral goals and programs on basis of evaluation and assessment, and provide instruction and intervention to students who have multiple disabilities. Assemble instructional materials and tools; provide instruction in physical and social development, personal care, occupational skills and academic areas. Provide work direction and training to instructor assistants, one-on-one aides and/or volunteers assigned to assist in classroom and with extracurricular activities. At times, prepares and maintains required reports and records and attends and/or conducts meetings and training.

Working conditions may exist that are not such as normally exist in the occupation of the public employee such as exposure to blood borne pathogens, communicable diseases, potentially infectious materials, and/or aggressive behavior. As necessary, employee shall comply with safety rules established for the purpose of fulfilling compliance with Ohio Employment Risk Reduction Standards, Rules, or Orders, through the utilization of protective equipment and decontamination procedures.


