Teacher(s)

(Intervention Specialist for students with mild to intensive disabilities)

QUALIFICATIONS: Must be able to present valid credentials for a Bachelor's degree in special education, **or related field with Ohio Department of Education Intervention Specialist licensure in the areas of mild/moderate or moderate/intensive needs, or ability to obtain** supplemental certification with the goal of further education; knowledge of methods in teaching students who have multiple disabilities; use of educational equipment and aids. Ability to define problems, collect data, establish facts and draw valid conclusions. Must have ability to maintain good rapport with students, parents, staff and other significant persons. Excellent cooperation and communication skills are essential. Applicant must be able to lift moderately heavy objects and physically assist non-ambulatory students. Successful applicants must pass all background checks, including FBI and BCII criminal records check and a urinalysis drug screening.

JOB DESCRIPTION GUIDELINES: Includes, but is not limited to the following -- Assesses developmental levels of students and gathers evaluative data, plans and implements instructional and behavioral goals and programs on basis of evaluation and assessment and provides instruction and intervention to students who have multiple disabilities. Assembles instructional materials and tools; provides instruction in all academic areas, physical and social development, personal care, occupational skills. Plans and provides extracurricular activities and experiences; exercises disciplinary action as appropriate and within board policy guidelines. Provides work direction and training to instructor assistants, aides and/or volunteers assigned to assist in classroom and with extracurricular activities. Prepares and maintains required reports and records and attends and/or conducts meetings and conferences.

Working conditions may exist that are not such as normally exist in the occupation of the public employee such as exposure to blood borne pathogens, communicable diseases, potentially infectious materials, and/or aggressive behavior. As necessary, employee shall comply with safety rules established for the purpose of fulfilling compliance with Ohio Employment Risk Reduction Standards, Rules, or Orders, through the utilization of protective equipment and decontamination procedures.
